GENERAL REGULATIONS POULTRY

- All poultry to be watered after judging (RSPCA By-Law)
- 1. Infested or diseased birds shall be withdrawn from the Poultry Pavilion and the entry fee will be forfeited by the exhibitor
- 2. Judging shall be by the Australian Poultry Standards. The British Standards will be used where appropriate. Judges will be advised of the judging standard prior to the judging on the day of the Show.
- 3. Exhibitors to be on the ground as stated in sections.
- 4. All livestock must be the property of the exhibitor at least one month before the date of the show.
- 5. Exhibitors may be required to make a statutory declaration regarding the accuracy of their entry if the committee so desire.
- 6. If any exhibitor gives a wrong description of his or her exhibit with the intention of deceiving the Society, he or she shall be disqualified from exhibiting at any future show and shall forfeit all fees paid.
- 7. All eggs are to be cracked and become the property of the Waroona Agricultural Society Poultry Club unless arrangements for particular eggs are made with the Chief Steward by the owner prior to judging.
- 8. Two birds per class per exhibitor
- 9. No exhibit can take more than one first prize in its or any other class.
- 10. The committee reserves the right of refusing or cancelling any entry without reason for so doing. The decision of the committee on all points shall be final without recourse.
- 11. Theft of birds or eggs can result in life disqualification.
- 12. The judges may withhold prizes for such exhibits as they deem unworthy.
- 13. All poultry exhibits must be on the ground for judging by 8.30am.
- 14. Exhibits accepted between 7.00am—8.30am. Judging commences at 9.00am.
- 15. No appeal against decisions of the judges shall be entertained unless made in writing on the day of the Show and a deposit of \$4.00 made, which will be forfeited if the committee consider the same to be frivolous. Stewards to be made aware of the fact at the time. All appeals to be heard and decided on the day of the Show.
- 16. Exhibits must not be removed without permission of the stewards.
- 17. Vehicles not allowed on the Show Ground without prior permission.
- 18. All exhibits must be ready for judging, as their respective classes are called, otherwise they will not be allowed to compete.
 - a) All entries are received subject to these Show Regulations and By-

- laws, the special regulation in each section and to the uniform By law made under the Royal Agricultural Society Act, 1926.
- b) The Society may refuse any entry without giving any reason therefore.
- c) The committee may at any time disqualify from exhibiting either indefinitely or for such a period as they think fit, any exhibitor who has, in the opinion of the committee, been guilty of any breach of these regulations, or whose conduct, whether at or during any show of the Society has in the opinion of the committee been such that he is unfit to exhibit at any show of the Society.
- d) No person who has been disqualified from exhibiting at any show of the Royal Agricultural Society of Western Australia, Incorporated, or any show of the society affiliated therein, shall during the period of disqualification be allowed to act as agent, representative of the exhibitor at any show of the Society.
- e) During the period of disqualification, no entry will be received from any person disqualified by the Royal Agricultural Society of Western Australia, Incorporated and should any entry be accidentally accepted it shall be deemed to be invalid and the entry fee will be returned.
- 19. In the event of two exhibitors gaining an equal number of points, the one with the most first exhibits will be awarded the trophy.
- 20. The Society will be under no liability for any loss or damage suffered by or attributed to the negligence of the Society or any of its servants or otherwise howsoever.
- 21. All unclaimed prize money after two weeks to revert to the Society.
- 22. JUDGES ARE ADMITTED FREE. ALL OTHER ADMISSIONS TO BE CHARGED FOR ENTRY INTO SHOW GROUND.



REGULATION 17 LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

17.1 Exhibitor accepts

The lodgement of an Application of Entry form shall be deemed to be acknowledgment by the Exhibitor of his or her agreement that the Society shall be under no liability for:

17.1.1 No Liability for animals or birds Exhibited

the loss, injury or death of any animal, (including birds) Exhibited, whether caused by, or attributable to, the negligence of the Society, or of its servants or Agent, or otherwise howsoever;

17.1.2 No Liability for property Exhibited

any loss or damage occasioned to or by any property Exhibited, whether caused by, or attributable to, the negligence of the Society, or of its servants or Agent, or otherwise howsoever;

17.1.3 No Liability for other animals, property, Exhibitor or general public any injury or damage occasioned to any other animal or property Exhibited, or to any other Exhibitor, or to the general public, whether caused by, or attributable to, the negligence of the Society, or of its servants or Agent, or otherwise howsoever;

17.1.4 No Liability for contracting any disease or suffering animals or birds any loss or damage suffered by any Exhibitor as a result of any disease contracted or suffered by any animals (including birds) after, or as a consequence of any animal Exhibits, or their progeny, being brought onto the Showground.

17.2 No Liability for livestock sales

The Society and the Auctioneers of Royal Show Livestock Sales shall be under no liability to any Owner or purchaser of livestock (whether exhibited or otherwise) entered for sale or sold at any Waroona Show Livestock Sale:

17.2.1 No Liability for livestock auctioned

in respect of any loss or injury to such livestock; whether such loss or injury be caused by or be attributable to, the negligence of the Auctioneers specified in the Regulations relating to the Waroona Show Livestock Sales or to the Society or any of its servants or Agents;

17.2.2 No Liability for other livestock, property, Exhibitor or general public

for any injury or damage occasioned to any other livestock or property, or to any other Exhibitor, or to the general public, whether caused by, or attributable to, the negligence of the Auctioneers specified in the Regulations relating to the Waroona Show Livestock Sales or to the Society or any of its servants or Agents;

17.2.3 No Liability for consequential loss and loss of profits

for any loss or damage (including without limitation consequential loss and loss of profits) suffered by any Owner or purchaser of livestock as a result of any disease contracted or suffered by any livestock after, or as a consequence of any livestock being entered for sale, at any Waroona Show Livestock Sale.
